

HERITAGE WORKER

This is a new post and the person appointed will work to ensure the long-term sustainability of the Circuit heritage sites by developing and implementing a coherent Circuit Heritage Strategy, with a clear emphasis on mission. They will have the ability to use the history and heritage of the Circuit to manage projects which develop relationships and engage with people of all ages and backgrounds through creative activities and events.

The appointment is initially for a fixed term of 2 years, which may be extended depending on future funding being available.

The role will primarily be based at Mount Zion Heritage Chapel and Heptonstall Methodist Church and may include occasional evening and weekend work.

The appointment requires an enhanced DBS disclosure and satisfactory references.

An occupational requirement exists for the postholder to be a practising Christian.
