### **We are seeking to appoint a part-time Circuit Dementia Worker to support churches across the Circuit.**

We are looking for someone who can support the Circuit's Churches in meeting the needs of people living with dementia and their carers, in whatever way is required, whether in improving the environment, in providing advice on appropriate activities and faith-based reflections, or in offering support.

This is a new post and the person appointed will be required:

- To work in partnership with churches to provide advice on appropriate activities and worship styles.
- To assist churches in creating a dementia inclusive environment.
- To provide a link with appropriate external organisations.
- To be an accessible source of support and advice to everyone across the Circuit.

Applicants will need to have previous relevant experience and be able to travel to venues across the Circuit on a regular basis.

An Enhanced DBS disclosure will be required for this position.
